

FASP Award for Outstanding Administrator of the Year (2010)

Purpose

To identify and recognize an outstanding administrator who supports the professional practice of school psychology in Florida. Prospective candidates can include: School Psychology administrators, Exceptional Student Education administrators, school principals, student services directors, county level supervisory staff members, school district superintendents, etc.

Who is Eligible?

- School Psychology administrators, Exceptional Student Education administrators, school principals, student services directors, county level supervisory staff members, school district superintendents.
- Individuals nominated may not be currently serving on the FASP Executive Board

Criteria for the Award

- Communicates with staff and is available and responsive to staff input and needs
- Demonstrated knowledge of professional issues and trends
- Encourages innovative practice
- Supports active involvement in professional activities (encourages attendance at professional growth activities, encourages involvement with the local, state and national associations).

Procedures, Required Documents and Timelines

- Nominators will be contacted and asked to help obtain information for the committee. When possible, three school psychologists acquainted with each nominee will be asked to complete professional recommendations regarding the nominee.

Selection and Notification and Award Presentation

- The awards committee will review the assembled materials on all candidates, using a decision matrix.
- The recipient's travel expenses to receive the award (transportation and one night's lodging at the Annual Conference hotel room rate) will be reimbursed by FASP. The recipient is contacted to request attendance at the Annual Conference, but the actual selection is not announced until the Annual Conference.
