



FASP CHILDREN'S SERVICES FUND, INC.

The Florida Association of School Psychologists (FASP) is the professional organization for approximately 1100 school psychologists working in Florida's 67 school districts and in a variety of private and community settings throughout the state. Children's Service Fund, Inc. (CSFI), conceived by FASP, was founded in August of 1999 and became a tax-exempt, 501© (3) charitable organization, in February of 2000. The mission of the FASP CSFI is to provide direct and indirect services that promote the educational and psychological well-being of Florida's needy children and families. The purpose of Children's Services Fund Incorporated (CSFI) fundraising projects, aligned with the organization's mission, is to raise money to provide grants available to school psychologists and other professionals throughout Florida to help meet the needs of the children they serve.

Each year, FASP members organize a number of fundraisers. Ninety-five percent of all funds raised go directly to Florida's students and families in need of assistance. The money is distributed through two types of CSFI grants. The first is considered an emergency grant for when a crisis occurs in the state of Florida and involves our children, youth, and families. The second type of grant, or a regular grant, is applied for through a CSFI member and can be used for a project to benefit children academically, socially, and/or emotionally. Both types of grants must meet the CSFI mission statement/goals and be approved by the CSFI Executive Board members.

In 2001, according to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, an area in need of improvement for Florida was in providing school services that appropriately match the educational and/ or psychosocial needs of the children. This is exactly what FASP CSFI was created to do. We are requesting monetary donations to assist in the CSFI mission to help children in need.
