

Shaniya Morris is a certified school psychologist serving in Collier County. Although new to the role in its formal capacity, she brings years of experience supporting students, families, and educators across diverse settings. She holds an Education Specialist degree in School Psychology from Florida International University (FIU) and a master's degree in Developmental Psychology from the University of Dundee in Scotland.

Her professional background includes work as an ABA therapist supporting autistic children and those with behavioral disorders in clinical, school, and home environments. She also served as a Specialist One-to-One Study Skills Support provider at the university level in Scotland, gaining extensive experience with learners across developmental stages and a wide range of academic, behavioral, and social-emotional needs.

Shaniya's leadership experience includes serving as president of the School Psychology Student Association (SPSA) at FIU and contributing to district-level implementation of multi-tiered systems of support (MTSS), with a particular focus on English language learners. She has delivered professional development for teachers on using psychoeducational reports to guide classroom support and for school psychologists on best practices for evaluating multilingual students. A dedicated member of FASP since graduate school, Shaniya currently serves as chair of the Planning and Development Committee. In this role, she has built strong relationships across districts and career stages, gaining a deep understanding of the needs and concerns of Florida's school psychologists.
